If service is required on a vehicle's Tire Pressure Monitor System (TPMS), remote keyless entry, or Intelligent Key, the Signal Tech II (special tool J-50190) can be used for diagnostics.

- Activate and display TPMS Sensor IDs
- Display tire pressure reported by the TPMS sensor
- Read TPMS DTCs and register TPMS IDs
- Store and print reports for warrantable repairs
- Check Intelligent Key relative signal strength
- Test remote keyless entry relative signal strength
- Confirm vehicle Intelligent Key antenna relative signal strength output
- Read ENGINE DTCs
